SPOTLIGHT ON ATTENDANCE.

Being around teachers and friends in a school environment is the best way for pupils to learn and reach their potential. Time in school also keeps children safe and provides access to pastoral care. That's why school attendance is so important.

Being in school is important for your child's achievement, wellbeing and wider development. Evidence shows that students with the highest attendance throughout their time at school gain the best GCSE and A-Level results. Research also found that pupils who performed better at the end of KS2 missed fewer days of school than those who didn't perform as well.

What are the risks of missing school?

Every moment in school counts and days missed add up quickly. For example, a child missing two days of school, each month will miss 18 days across the whole year. The higher a pupil's attendance, the more likely they are to learn and the better prepared they are for their future.

Data from 2019 shows that 84% of KS2 pupils who had 100% attendance achieved the expected standard compared to 40% of pupils who missed 18 days a year or more.

What if my child needs to miss school?

Parents and carers have a legal duty to ensure your child gets full-time education. There are only a small number of circumstances where missing a school day is permitted. Your child must attend every day that the school is open, unless:

*Your child is too ill to attend.

*You have asked in advance and been given permission by the school for your child to be absent on a specific day due to exceptional circumstances.

*Your child cannot go to school on a specific day because the are observing a religious event.

*Your local authority is responsible for arranging your child's transport to school and it's not available or has not been provided yet.

These are the only circumstance where schools can permit your child to be absent.


